Sub: Disclosure to Stock Exchanges

This is in reference to our earlier communication dated 12 February 2015, with respect to the *prima facie* orders of the Competition Commission of India (CCI) directing investigation into allegations of abuse of dominance in relation to our residential projects - 'Regal Gardens at DLF Garden City' and 'Sky Court Project', in Gurgaon.

We are writing to update you on the Hon'ble CCI's separate orders in the above cases (Case No.'s 73 and 84 of 2014), both dated 31 August 2018, by way of which the Hon'ble CCI has dismissed the aforesaid allegations of abuse of dominant position, and closed these cases against DLF Ltd. as well as DLF Home Developers Limited (DHDL), a wholly owned subsidiary of DLF Ltd. (i.e. the DLF Group). The Hon'ble CCI has observed that the DLF Group does not enjoy a dominant position in the market for development and sale of residential apartments / flats in Gurgaon, and that the relevant market is dynamic by its very nature and keeps changing with time. In light of the absence of dominance of the DLF Group in the relevant market, the Hon'ble CCI held that there was no requirement to examine allegations of abuse of dominance.

We humbly submit that the Company consistently has and continues to adhere to the best governance and compliance practices in all aspects of its business.
