Key upgrades include a 215-ft road from Cyberabad Police Commissioner's office to Gachibowli and a 150-ft road from Anjaiah Nagar to Ramky Towers. At Khajaguda, plans include a three-lane flyover (Nanakramguda to Tolichowki) and a three-lane underpass (Tolichowki to Biodiversity Junction). This network of roads when completed will ease access to DLF Cyber City, Hyderabad, from all major corridors of the city.

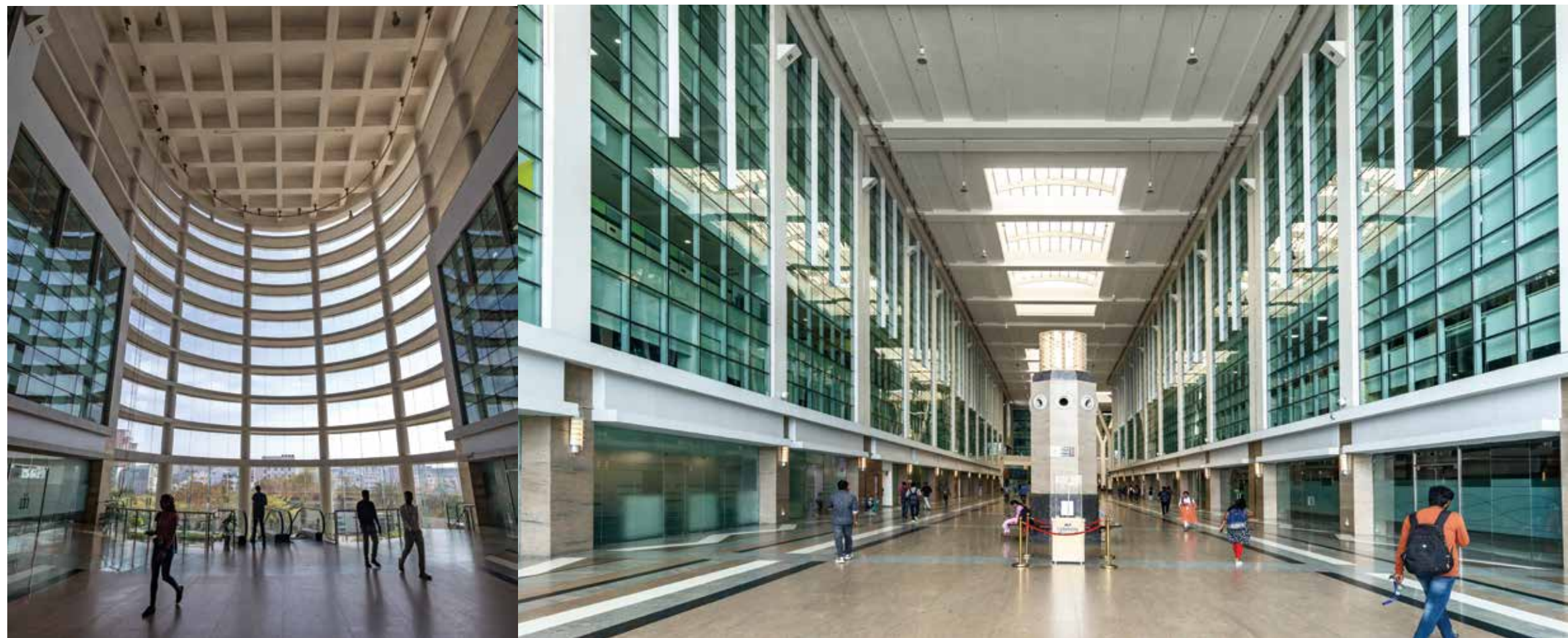

PRIDE OF AN INSIDER

Venu Goud traces the rise of DLF Cyber City, Hyderabad, from the day he first set foot in Gachibowli to launch the visionary project

I grew up in Sircilla, a quiet suburban town near Hyderabad, then part of Andhra Pradesh, now a vital thread in Telangana's vibrant fabric. Even as a child, I was drawn to the magic of machines, captivated by how things worked. That curiosity matured into a pursuit of electrical engineering, laying the foundation for a career that began in manufacturing in 1994 that branched into real estate by 2005.

My real estate journey began under the mentorship of an established developer. Nearly two decades later, a pivotal moment arrived. In 2013, I received a call from DLF Offices, inviting me to lead operations for an ambitious new venture in Gachibowli.

At the time, Gachibowli was considered the edge of Hyderabad, much like Gurugram was once to Delhi. 'Old Hyderabad' remained the city's cultural and commercial nucleus, while Gachibowli and Cyberabad were known more for weekend retreats and farmhouses than thriving business districts.

But DLF saw what others hadn't yet imagined.

In 2004, the company launched DLF Cyber City, Hyderabad, anticipating the rise of India's IT revolution. Microsoft had just established a presence in the city, and Indian IT giants were expanding rapidly. With the city's core running out of space, the government stepped in, and began inviting tech giants such as Microsoft, Wipro, and Infosys to Gachibowli. Land was also allotted to the Indian School of Business (ISB), a move that signalled the state's commitment to fostering a knowledge economy.

What followed was a remarkable transformation.



Cyberabad, with Gachibowli at its heart, became the city's new frontier. For leading IT firms, DLF Cyber City, Hyderabad, emerged as the address of choice. Its sprawling floorplates, campus-like atmosphere, and bustling food court catered to both operational efficiency and employee experience.

DLF Offices has since set new standards — not just for Hyderabad or India, but globally — in safety, sustainability, and operational excellence.

Today, I'm proud to say DLF Cyber City, Hyderabad, holds a rare constellation of accolades: the 'Sarvashreshtha Suraksha Puraskar' (Golden Trophy) from the National Safety Council of India, LEED Zero Waste and Zero Energy certifications, LEED Platinum, WELL certification, the Sword of Honour from the British Safety Council, and multiple recognitions for security excellence and green landscaping from the Telangana government.

To our clients, these aren't just trophies, they're strategic assets. They showcase a commitment to world-class standards in sustainability, safety, and performance, helping tenants win trust and business from global partners.

But the impact runs deeper. DLF Cyber City, Hyderabad, has driven local job creation, community safety, and civic support. Our fire tenders have aided emergency efforts, and our CSR wing maintains the DLF Road's public median. From festive celebrations to ongoing partnerships with NGOs, we've stayed rooted to the community.



Now, a new chapter begins.

With every upgrade, I, alongside the phenomenal team at DLF Cyber City, Hyderabad, remain energised by a singular mission: to nurture this legacy, setting benchmarks that don't just meet global standards, but boldly redefine them.

AN OUTSIDER'S ODE

Arunabha Bhattacharya chronicles his journey through Hyderabad, where discovery turned to belonging, and in the city's eclectic warmth, he quietly fell in love

As a true-blooded *Dilliwallah*, my perceptions of Hyderabad were shaped more by fragments of conversation and fleeting layovers than by any substantial experience.

Like many in the north of the Vindhyas, I reduced this southern city to a caricature: searing heat, the towering Charminar, and an insatiable appetite for biryani. In my imagination, Hyderabad was a city forever in the shadow of Bengaluru's IT acclaim — quaint, perhaps even charming, but hardly a rival. Its mention conjured memories of sports legends — VVS Laxman's elegance, Mohammad Azharuddin's wristy flair, Sania Nehwal and PV Sindhu's power and grace, and the quiet heroism of Hanuma Vihari during India's 2021 Test series triumph in Australia.

So, when I landed in Hyderabad in March 2024, I came with the swagger of someone bred in the chaos and grandeur of Delhi, expecting, at best, a modest city adorned with nostalgia. How profoundly mistaken I was.

Hyderabad was, in parts, exactly what I had imagined but to define it by its stereotypes would be to miss its soul entirely. The city unfolded before me like a richly layered novel, each chapter more compelling than the last.

The Rajiv Gandhi International Airport at Shamshabad, constantly evolving, surprisingly seamless, was the first whisper of what was to come. A drive along the impressive Outer Ring Road (ORR), which could easily rival the best expressways in the country, brought me into the heart of the city's new avatar. As the skyline of the financial district loomed into view, I found myself

wondering if I had taken a detour into Singapore or Dubai. The gleaming towers of HITEC City and Gachibowli shimmered like sentinels of progress, their lights etching outlines against the night sky in silent defiance of any old-world labels.

The view from the Durgam Cheruvu bridge at twilight, with glass façades reflecting a technicolor sky over the river, was nothing short of cinematic. And it was here that Hyderabad began to speak to me, not in grand proclamations, but in confident whispers. The city was not merely catching

up with Bengaluru; it was scripting a future on its own terms.

Yet, what makes Hyderabad truly unique is its ability to wear modernity and tradition in seamless harmony. Its cosmopolitan essence, a legacy of the Nizam's benevolent rule, remains intact. I, a migrant with no roots in the Deccan, have never once felt like an outsider. The lilting charm of Hyderabad Hindi, with its warm cadences and poetic inflections, somehow feels more familiar than even the stern grammar of its northern cousin. Much like how the spices of a biryani fuse into a singular experience, one blends effortlessly into the social fabric of Hyderabad.

The old city is an entire world unto itself — steeped in time, yet breathing in the present. The Charminar stands not just as a monument but as a memory etched in stone. The Salar Jung Museum, Chowmahalla Palace,



and the dignified Osmania General Hospital, all speak of a refined aesthetic and a holistic vision. At the original Café Niloufer, a bite of Bun Maska and a sip of Irani Chai transport you to a slower, gentler era. And of course, the biryani, never just food, but an experience, is best had at the original Shah Ghouse.

What continually amazes me, however, is the foresight of Hyderabad's erstwhile rulers. From dams and libraries to girls' schools and universities, their vision encompassed every aspect of civilisational progress. It is no wonder that Hyderabad has managed to retain its inclusive ethos; and that I, like so many others before me, find it so easy to call this place home.

Professionally, I find myself in the heart of Hyderabad's new frontier — DLF Cyber City. To call it DLF Offices' crown jewel is not mere hyperbole; it is a fact borne out by every metric. The city may know DLF from its iconic presence in Gurugram and Chennai, but here, in Hyderabad, stands its number one asset. A bold statement? Perhaps. But it's one I stand by with pride.

DLF Cyber City, Hyderabad, leads the portfolio in every sense: the first to be powered entirely by green energy, the first to earn LEED Zero Water, LEED Zero Waste, and now, the prestigious LEED Zero Energy certification. Add to that a LEED Platinum rating, WELL certification, and

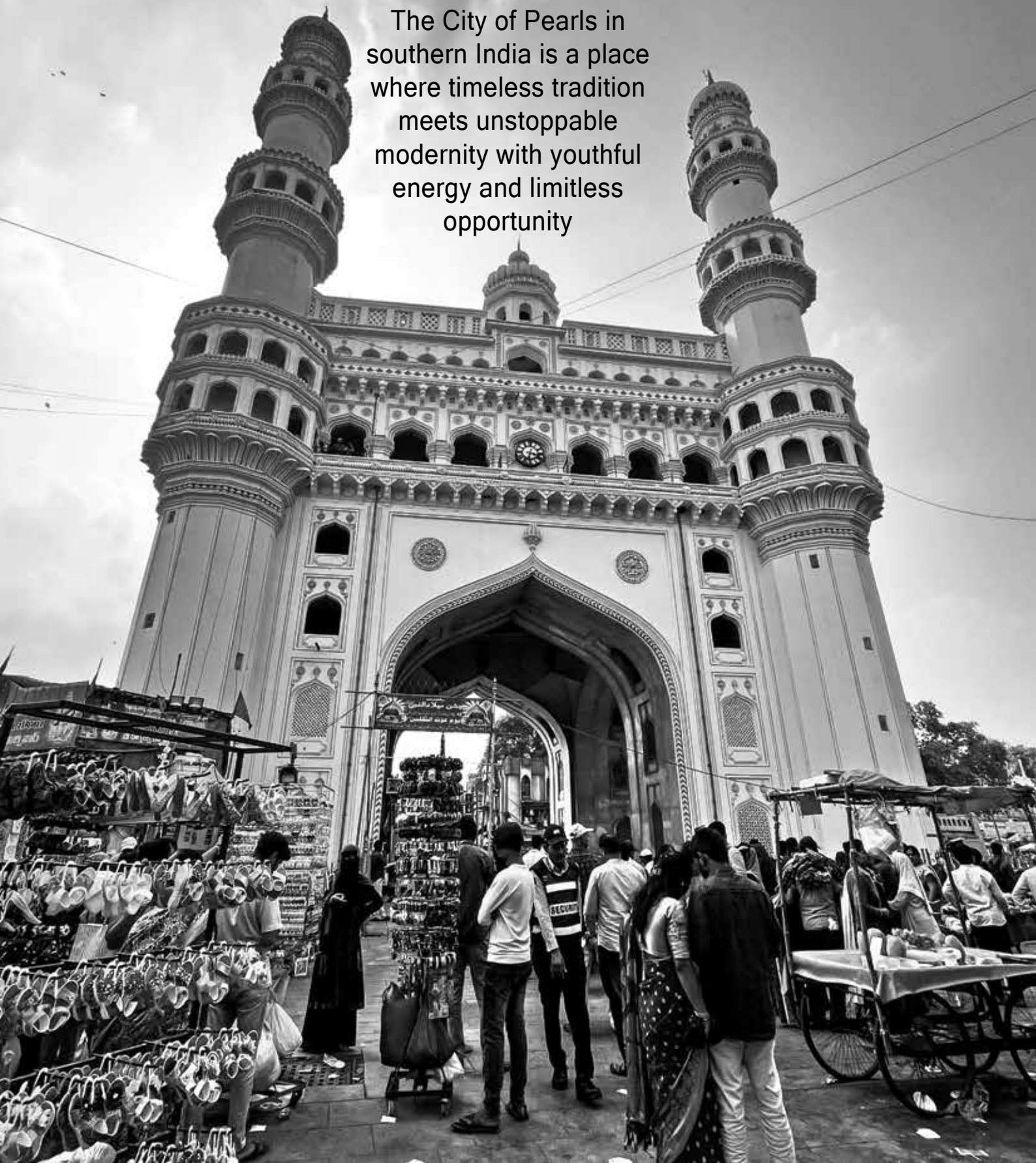

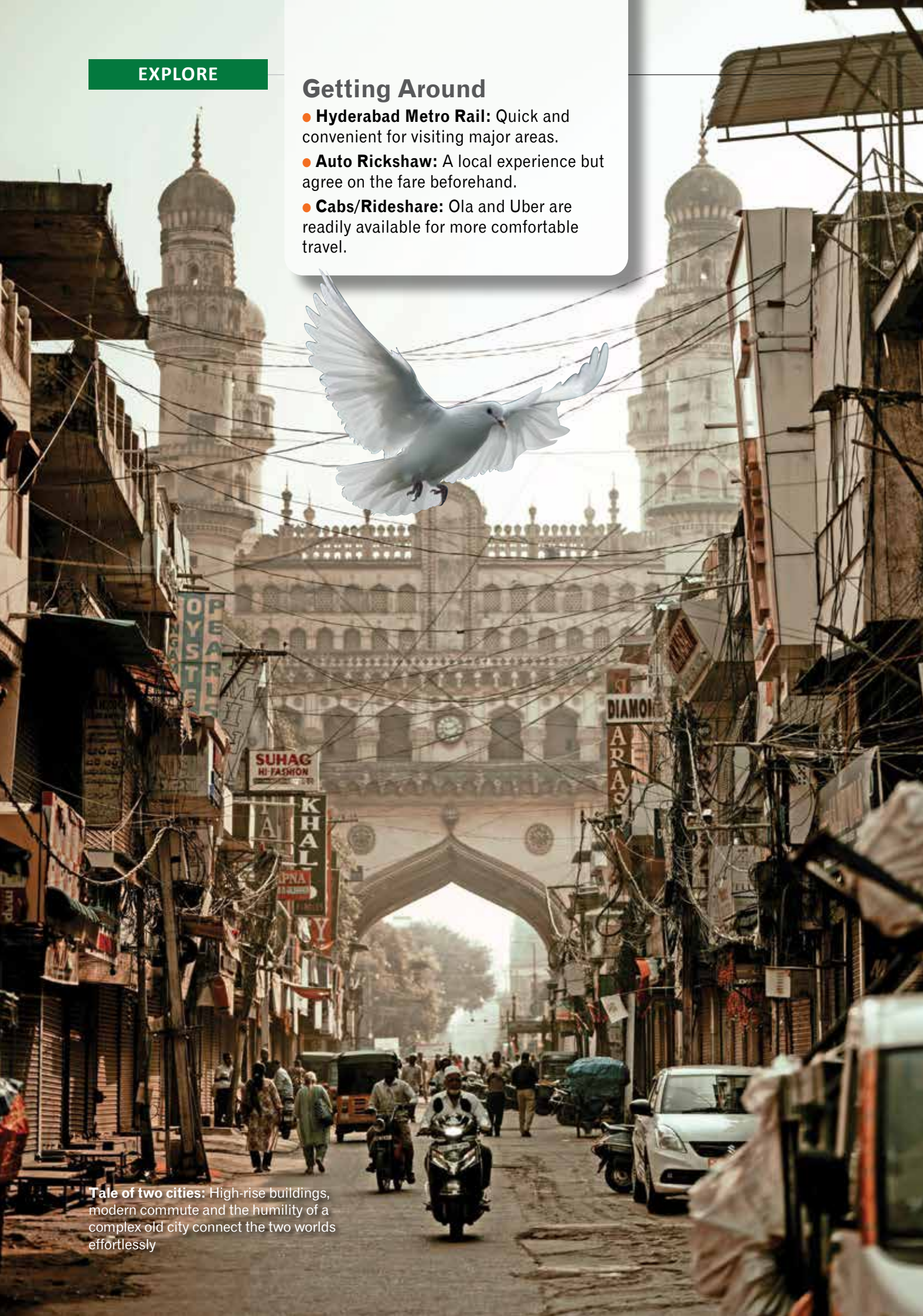

ROYAL LEGACY IN EVERY BITE

The Hyderabadi biryani is above spice and flavour. It's a love letter to the city itself—rich, complex, and utterly timeless

Flavoured to kill: Slow-cooked, spice-kissed, and steeped in tradition, the Hyderabadi biryani is the soul of Telangana cuisine

Hyderabadi biryani isn't just a dish; it's a saga of spices, royal kitchens, and centuries of culinary evolution. If you've ever tasted it, you'll know—there's a story in every grain of rice, a legacy in every morsel of meat, and a history that lingers in your senses long after the meal is over. To understand Hyderabadi biryani, you need to peel back the layers—not just of the spices, but of the culture, the people, and the era that gave it birth.

A Royal Birth

The legend of Hyderabadi biryani begins in the 16th century, but the dish we know today came into its own in the kitchens of the Nizams of Hyderabad in the 18th century. The kacchi biryani, often touted as the original Hyderabadi style, is a meticulous affair. Raw marinated meat is layered at the bottom of the pot, followed by partially cooked rice. The pot is sealed, the heat is turned low, and for hours, the flavours slowly blend

together, infusing each grain of rice with the richness of the meat and spices. It's an art form, one that requires patience and the right technique — nothing short of a chef's mastery.

His kacchi biryani is considered the epitome of perfection, a dish that captures the essence of tradition while maintaining a level of precision that only a handful can replicate. His meticulous attention to detail and ability to balance the spices has earned him legions of loyal customers.

On the other hand, the pakki biryani is for those who can't wait. The meat is pre-cooked, the rice parboiled, and then they're layered together before being sealed for a brief cooking period. It's quicker, yes, but the result is no less aromatic or flavourful. Both styles boast the same ingredients — the same fragrant rice, the same heady blend of spices — but it's the method that truly defines the experience.

Sajid Ali, the culinary genius behind Bawarchi, has elevated the pakki version of the dish to new heights. His biryani is a testament to how the simplest ingredients can come together in the most extraordinary way when prepared with skill and passion. Known for his innovative touch, Sajid's approach blends the old-world charm of traditional cooking with a fresh perspective that appeals to today's taste.

Spice Symphony

If there's one thing that sets Hyderabad biryani apart, it's the signature spice blend. There's no one-size-fits-all recipe, no set formula for the perfect biryani. A blend of cloves, cinnamon, cardamom, black cumin, and bay leaves forms the backbone, but the true magic

lies in how these spices are balanced. It's in the way the saffron threads weave their golden hue through the rice, infusing it with an unmistakable aroma. Or the caramelised onions (*birista*) that add an earthy sweetness, balancing the heat of the spices.

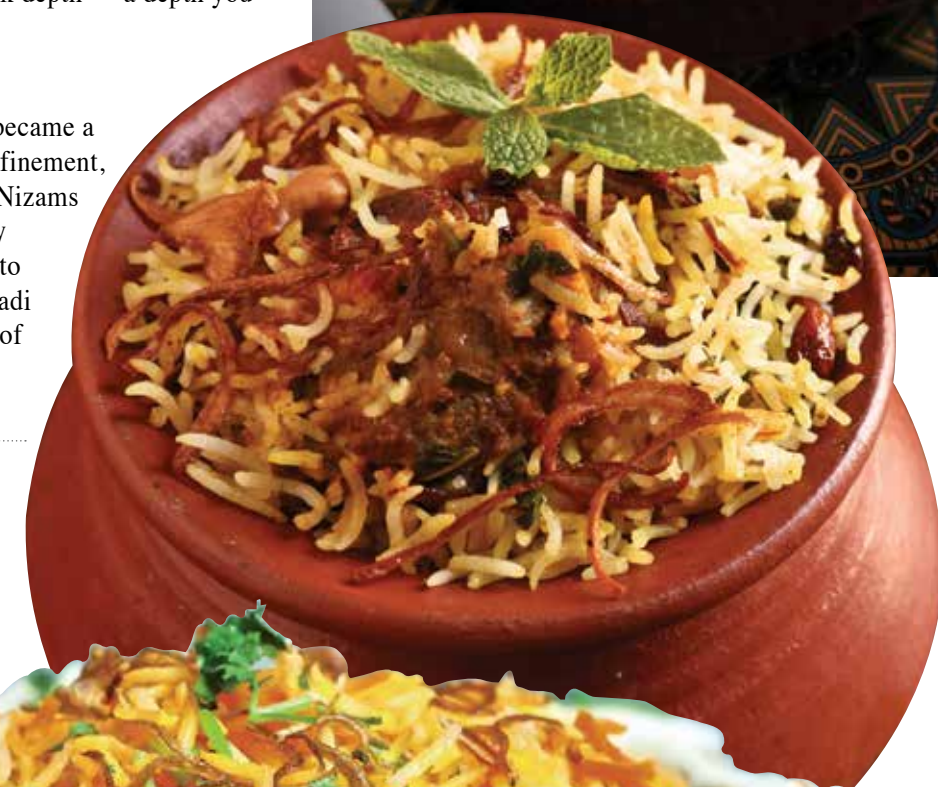
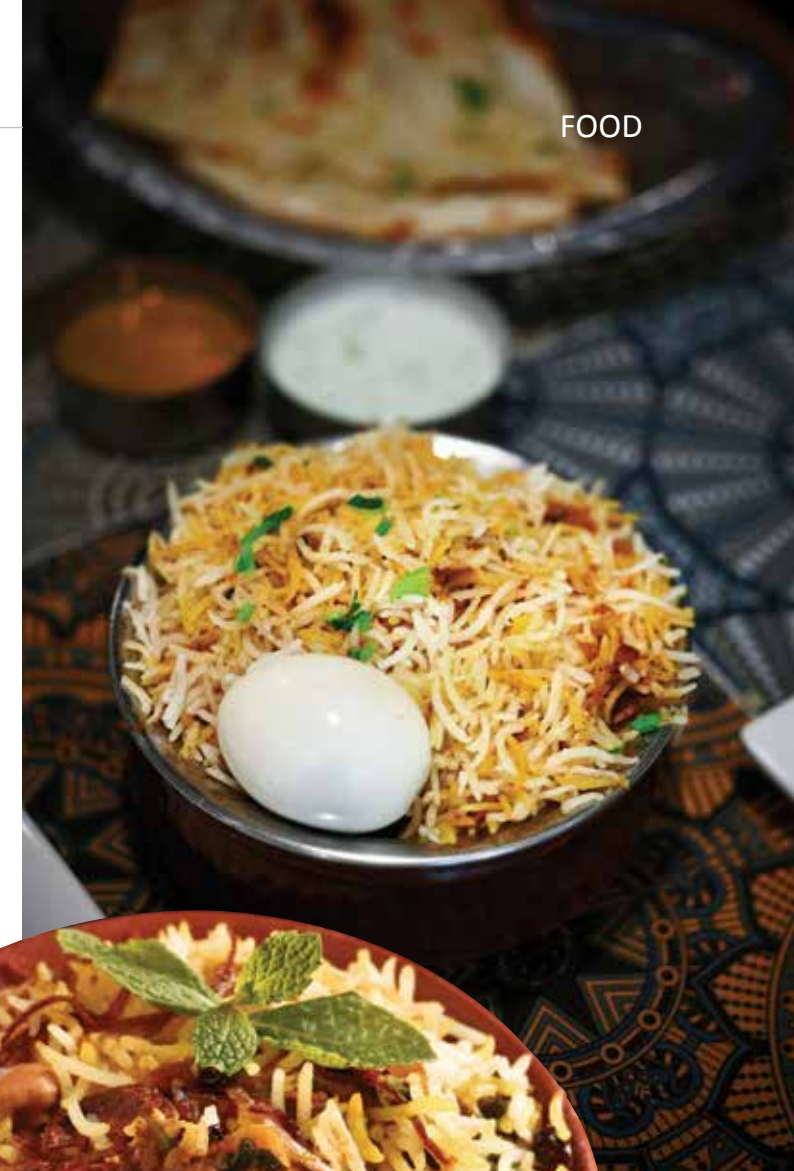
The marination of the meat — typically goat, chicken, or beef — is equally crucial. Yogurt, ginger, garlic, and a host of ground spices tenderise the meat, allowing it to soak up all the flavours before it's cooked. This is where the artistry of the chef shines through. Because, let's face it, anyone can cook rice and meat. But to make it sing? That requires knowledge, patience, and an understanding of how spices work their magic.

And then there's the "dum" cooking — slow, slow, slow. The pot is sealed with dough, ensuring that no steam escapes. This method, when done right, traps all the flavours, making the biryani incredibly aromatic, rich, and complex. It's this slow cooking that gives the Hyderabad biryani its trademark depth — a depth you simply can't rush.

Nizams' Legacy

Hyderabad, under the Nizams, became a centre of culture, wealth, and refinement, and its food reflected that. The Nizams didn't just enjoy their food, they celebrated it. From royal feasts to simple family dinners, Hyderabad biryani became an integral part of their culinary identity.

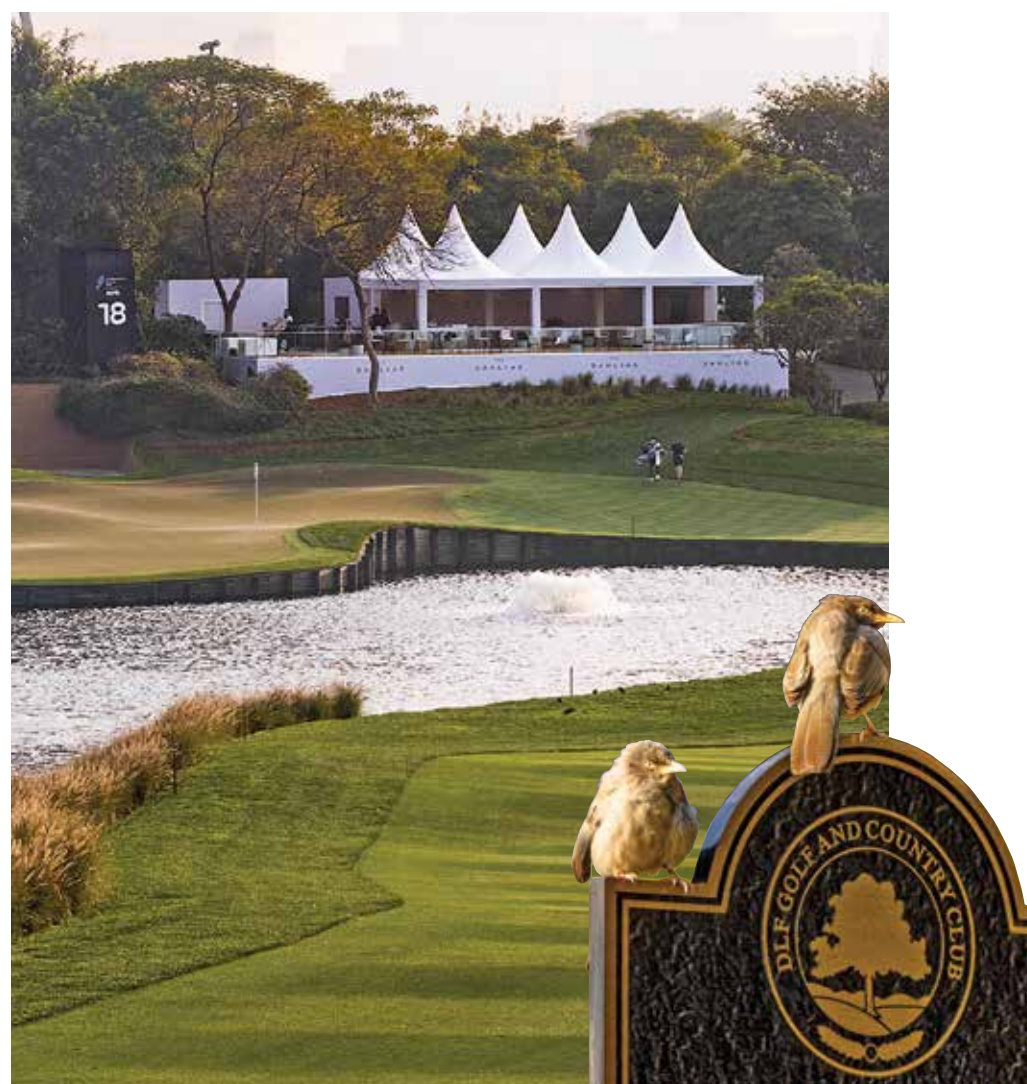
